❖ Discussion about Friday evening

- Registration
 - In reference to rules, tables are not for sitting, as it was noticed was going on while registration was occurring. Noted and is consciously being avoided by most.
 - Uneven distribution of Touch Groups is a main concern, perhaps a method other than marker on hand, or maybe using a sharpie so numbers can't be changed. Trial and error really, but people can be switched as need be.
 - Some forms and money were received as late as Sunday. This was from late arrivals though, so can be avoided by simply reminding the late arrivals earlier on and being more conscious of whether one has turned in their money and forms yet.
 - The responsibilities and work involved in the registrar position should be explained in more detail to Jack, as they may have been a bit vague. But for a first run, he's done well.
- Opening circle

❖ Discussion about Saturday events

- Workshops
